Ádam Raga occupies the second place in the classification at the Trial Outdoor World Championship after the Grand Prix in Portugal

The GAS GAS rider Ádam Raga managed to go through the two tests of the Grand Prix of Portugal that was held in Paços de Ferreira and kept his second place in the overall classification of the Trial Outdoor World Championship.

During the test held last Saturday, the rider Ádam Raga got to the podium, this time beaten only by Albert Cabestany and Toni Bou, who had an excellent and flawless performance. Last Sunday, Raga got a third place once again; on the podium with him were Takahisa Fujinami Albert Cabestany, who got first and second place respectively. The rider Toni Bou came after Raga and got fourth place.

After this weekend, the overall classification is still being led by Toni Bou with 53 points, and that is only six points ahead of Ádam Raga, who comes right before Fujinami and Albert Cabestany.

In regard to the other two GAS GAS riders, James Dabill ended up sixth last Saturday and seventh last Sunday; and the French Loris Gubian got the eighth place in both tests.

The fourth part of this World Championship will take place next 5th and 6th of June in Motegi, Japan.
