Ádam Raga, second position in the opening round of the outdoor World Trial Championship (Baiona)

The GASGAS rider Adam Raga finished in second position in the first race of the 2010 World Outdoor Trial Championship which was held this past weekend in Northwestern Spain at Baiona (Pontevedra). Raga maintained a battle with Jeroni Fajardo, to which he finally emerged victorious by three points. Toni Bou completed the race for the final victory.

"It was not a good beginning because it cost to me to adapt me to the circuit, but soon I have was able to improve, gaining the second position and believe that it has been a good result" pointed out Raga as he is reclaiming his better form and he is confident that he will provide good competition for Toni Bou in the fight for the title. On the other hand, James Dabill finished in the sixth position and the young Frenchman Loris Gubian finished in eighth place.

The riders were under the enforcement of the new regulation and had only one minute to complete each section (thirty seconds less time than in the past) based on the rules of the 2010 World Championship.

The second and third race of the World Championship will be held weekend, Saturday and Sunday, in the Portuguese locality of Paços de Ferreira.
