Ádam Raga still holds his second place position at the Trial World Championship in the UK Grand Prix

The GAS GAS rider Ádam Raga is still holding his second place position in the overall classification of the Trial Outdoor World Championship. This is after the sixth test of the competition, which was held last weekend in the city of Fort William, in Scotland.

Raga ended up fourth in each of the tests held last weekend; and he is now only 17 points behind the rider who is, by now, leading the championship, Toni Bou.

Toni Bou got first place in the first test, followed by the British rider Dougie Lampkin and the Japanese Takahisa Fujinami. In the second test, held on Sunday, the riders who got to the podium were Fujinami, Albert Cabestany and Toni Bou.

With regard to the other GAS GAS riders, the British James Dabill ended up seventh on Saturday and fifth on Sunday. The French rider Loris Gubian got the thirteenth place in the first test; but he was not able to compete on Sunday due to a sharp pain in his knee.

In the 'Youth' category, the GAS GAS rider Pol Tarrés got first place on Saturday and second place on Sunday. In the 'Junior' category, his fellow rider Pere Borrellas got fourth in the test held on Sunday.

The next test of this Trial World Championship will take place on July 11th in the French city of Saint Michel de Maurienne.
